## Biography - Brad Camp

Brad Camp was born and raised in **Massachusetts** and currently calls Colorado Springs home. He attended Wheaton College (physical education) for undergrad and Penn State University for his graduate education (performance psychology). Brad spent twenty years in the United States Army as a Military Police Officer serving both in the United States and overseas. He served as a Commander in special weapons security, recruiting, the World Class Athlete Program (WCAP) and as the liaison to Croatia. Brad was the key figure in the WCAP, a program that offers opportunities for military personnel to train to become Olympic and internationally competitive athletes.

Brad has an extensive background in business management, athletics and marketing. In addition to being Operating Officer of the Directorate of Community Activities directing community business and recreation programs at Fort Carson, Colorado, he previously was Deputy Director of the Center for Enhanced Performance at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, NY. There he designed, coordinated and implemented the Peak Performance Program (performance enhancement). For the last 6 years, Brad was the Chief Executive Officer of USA Archery.

Brad is a sports enthusiast—a three-sport letterman (football, wrestling, track) in high school and two-sport letterman in college (football, track).
