## DEADLINES

**All Entry Forms and Fees MUST be sent to your Region Office or Designee by their established deadline, with the exception of those teams who earned a bid for the Open Division at a Bid Tournament. Those teams MUST send their entry form and check DIRECTLY to the USAV Event Department and send copies of their entry form and check to their Region.** The remaining forms can be sent with the entry forms, mailed separately to the USAV Events Office, or brought directly to the tournament. It is **STRONGLY** suggested that you send ALL materials by the following deadlines. Please make copies of **ALL** materials sent and bring them with you to the event.

## SPECIAL DEADLINE NOTES

- **Open At-Large Teams** – Entries **WILL NOT** be accepted after the **May 14<sup>th</sup>** deadline.
- **Open Teams** – Bid Tournament winners will be in jeopardy of forfeiting your bid if your entry and check are not received by **March 12<sup>th</sup>**. If a team earns and accepts a bid at the East Coast Championships, the team **MUST** register through Advanced Event Systems by **June 2<sup>nd</sup>**. The Entry Form and check must be sent **DIRECTLY** to and received by the USAV Events Department by **5:00 P.M. MST June 3<sup>rd</sup>**.
- **Club Teams** – You may request late application for entry. A Club team must meet the following guidelines to apply for consideration after the **June 9<sup>th</sup>** deadline:
  1. Confirm Region approval
  2. Contact the Events Department to request application.
  - Applications **WILL NOT** be accepted if court space and field sizes are filled. There are **NO GUARANTEES** that a team entry will be accepted after the June 9<sup>th</sup> deadline. **Therefore, enter early!**

**USAV REGIONAL VOLLEYBALL ASSOCIATIONS (REGIONS) CANNOT GUARANTEE REGIONAL BERTHS IN ANY DIVISION. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE USAV EVENT DEPARTMENT AT THE NATIONAL OFFICE PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE FOR A TEAM TO BE ACCEPTED. DO NOT WAIT TO THINK ABOUT ENTERING ON-LINE. TEAM REGISTRATION(S) WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE POSTED DEADLINES. A WAITING LIST MAY BE USED IF THE NEED ARISES TO ROUND OFF POOLS.**

## TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN FOR TEAMS & CHAPERONES

All check-in procedures will take place at the Austin Convention Center. In an effort to make the registration process more efficient, we have designated the day before each age competition begins for check-in. We do encourage teams to check-in early if you are on site prior to your check-in date. However, priority will be given first to the age divisions designated to that day of check-in. Teams must be completely checked in prior to closure of registration (**9PM**) on their designated registration day. Teams that fail to check-in during this time frame will be subject to forfeiture of their first match of the tournament. Teams will no longer be allowed to check in the morning or afternoon of their first competition day. Please arrange travel accordingly to ensure you arrive on your check-in day. **This will be enforced! Teams that have not checked in by 9PM on their designated registration day will forfeit their first match and subsequent matches if complete check-in isn't acquired by those match times.**

**NEW FOR 2010: CHAPERONES ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED TO CHECK-IN SEPARATELY TO RECEIVE THEIR CREDENTIALS. THE CHAPERONE FORM MUST BE TURNED IN DURING THE TEAM CHECK-IN WITH A LEGIBLE COPY OF A VALID PHOTO ID ATTACHED FOR A TEAM'S CHECK-IN TO BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE. SEE CHAPTER 2 FOR MORE INFORMATION ON CHAPERONE ELIGIBILITY.**

- **Only one (1) team representative or coach should go to the check-in desk in the lobby of the Austin Convention Center to check-in the team(s).**
- The team representative/coach will receive printed programs, credentials and other information.
  - Schedules will be available online and at the Results Stations.
- The team representative/coach will verify the team roster, uniform numbers, and uniform. Once verified, the roster will be in effect throughout the Championships. **No additions or uniform number changes to the roster are allowed once play begins.** The team roster is limited to fifteen (15) players and five (5) adults. **ONLY** those persons whose names appear on the verified roster receive credentials and are permitted to sit on the bench.
