



2010-2011 USA Volleyball Officials' Complimentary Room Program (OCRP) For Junior National and National Referee Candidates

The Officials' Complimentary Room Program is established by USA Volleyball to help alleviate the lodging expense that officials incur when participating in USAV National Championship events. Candidates for Junior National or National Referee may or may not be eligible for this program. The following FAQ will help you determine your eligibility.

1. How many days must a referee officiate to be eligible for OCRP?

A referee must be available for six consecutive days of competition. On each of those days, a referee must have no conflicts and work a minimum of six matches per day.

2. If I am a Junior National or National Referee candidate and will be participating only in the rating process for three days, am I still eligible for OCRP?

No. We encourage you to seek assistance from your region and/or to find a fellow candidate as a roommate in order to share the expense.

3. I am a Junior National Referee candidate at the Girls' JNC and will be participating in the rating process (three days) AND a USAV Referee Training Camp (three days). This means I'll be there for six consecutive days. Am I eligible for OCRP?

No. Since candidates and campers pay the Officials' Commission to participate in the rating and training camp programs, the USAV Events Department does not receive any remuneration; therefore, the Events Department cannot provide complimentary rooms in this case.

4. If I am a National Referee candidate at the Boys' JNC and will be participating in the rating process (three days) but will be officiating for three additional days at the tournament, am I eligible for OCRP?

Yes, but you will have to pay for ½ the room cost for the three days during the rating session.

5. If I am a National Referee candidate at the Boys' JNC and will be participating in the rating process (three days) but will officiate the entire tournament, am I eligible for OCRP?

Yes. Same as #4 above.

6. How do I register for OCRP if I am eligible?

So for Junior National Referee candidates, even if they are participating at the event for at least six consecutive days (camp + rating session), they are not eligible for OCRP.

National Referee candidates may be eligible for OCRP if they work at least six days of the event, including three days during the rating process, but the candidate will be responsible for ½ the room cost during the rating session.
