

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT SCOREKEEPER MONITORS

Scorekeeper monitors are used in place of paid scorekeepers at the following Junior Volleyball Championships:

- Girls' Junior National Volleyball Championships
- Boys' Junior National Volleyball Championships

Each monitor is responsible for making sure that the scorekeeper for each match is knowledgeable and understands how to keep score. The monitor will be responsible for multiple courts during the day at the event.

Scorekeeper monitors must be one of the following:

- Certified USAV National Scorekeeper
- Certified USAV National Junior Scorekeeper
- Certified Regional-level Scorekeeper

Applications for scorekeeper monitor are available on the USA Volleyball website under Rules/officials - applications. The deadline for completing an application is **March 1st**. For specific dates and cities, refer to this year's application.

Scorekeeper monitors are considered Independent Contractors of the Junior National Championships. They have daily responsibilities and receive the same benefits as any other staff member. Some of the requirements of a scorekeeper monitor include:

1. Assist with scorekeeper clinics for players
2. Assist other tournament staffs with various duties
3. Work an 8-hour shift each day. *(If you are also certified as a referee, you might be able to referee a maximum of 2 matches per day, but are not guaranteed any matches.)*
4. Arrive at the tournament city by noon on the day prior to the tournament
5. Depart no earlier than 6:00 pm on the final day of the tournament
6. Possible assignment as a scorekeeper
7. Have a current background screen on file

In exchange for performing the above duties, the following will be provided:

1. Transportation Compensation Package
2. 50% of a hotel room – shared with another monitor or event staff member
3. Daily honorarium
4. Per Diem
5. Staff VIK

You will be notified by **March 15th** if you have been selected as a monitor and at which site. At this time, you will be sent an event contract, which you will need to sign and return. Someone from USAV Travel will contact you to make your transportation arrangements. Hotel and roommate selection will also be done by the USAV staff.
