

**RESOLUTION FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE
USA BOXING BOARD OF DIRECTORS
TO AMEND SECTION 101.7 OF THE USA BOXING RULES**

WHEREAS, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) is responsible for oversight of the worldwide Olympic Movement;

WHEREAS, the International Boxing Federation (AIBA) is recognized by the IOC as the International Federation for the sport Olympic-style boxing and the United States Olympic Committee (USOC) is recognized by the IOC as the National Olympic Committee for the United States;

WHEREAS, USA Boxing is recognized by both AIBA and the USOC as the National Governing Body in the United States for the sport of Olympic-style boxing;

WHEREAS, AIBA has created and is operating the new World Series of Boxing (WSB) that is recognized by both the IOC and the USOC with respect to Olympic qualification and participation; and

WHEREAS, USA Boxing desires for its athletes to be able to participate fully in the WSB provided that those athletes comply with the rules and regulations of the WSB.

WHEREAS, the World Series of Boxing is recognized by, and in compliance with, the World Anti Doping Agency's (WADA) policies and procedures

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT the following language shall be added as Section 101.7(6) of the USA Boxing Rules:

(6) USA Boxing recognizes the World Series of Boxing as an integral part of its U.S. amateur program and fully supports its athletes who elect to participate in the World Series of Boxing. The World Series of Boxing has its own set of technical rules that may change from time to time and USA Boxing recognizes that athletes who participate in the World Series of Boxing and who fully comply with the World Series of Boxing rules shall, under the AIBA rules, fully maintain their amateur status and are eligible to qualify for, and represent the United States in, the Olympic Games.
